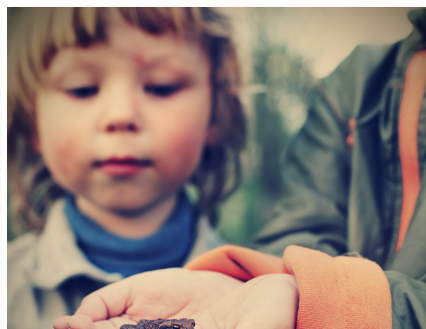

PlayOUT Foundation Annual Report 2018

Winter Solstice Celebration. We settled into the darkest night and subsequent turning toward the light in the company of good friends and a bonfire at St. Edward State Park.

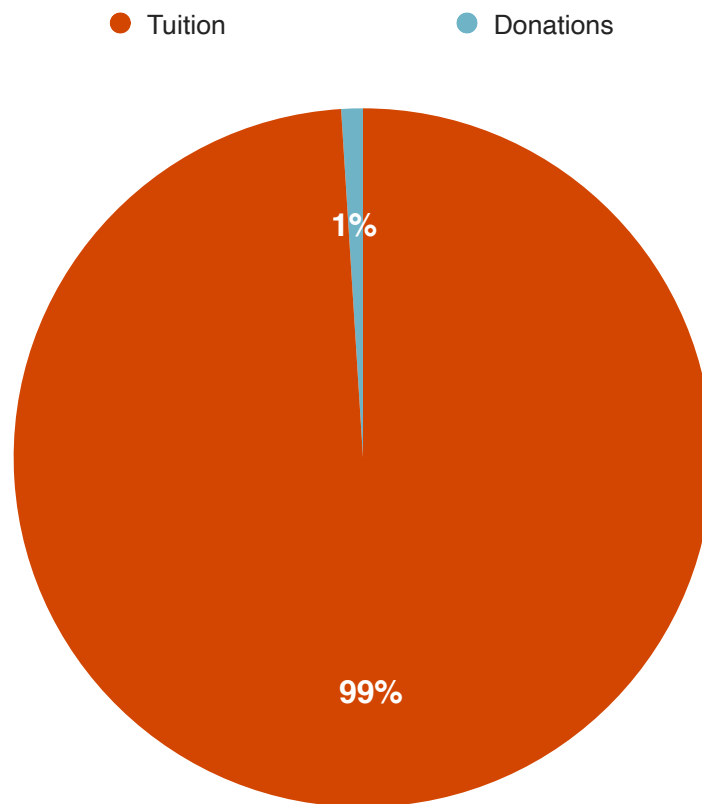

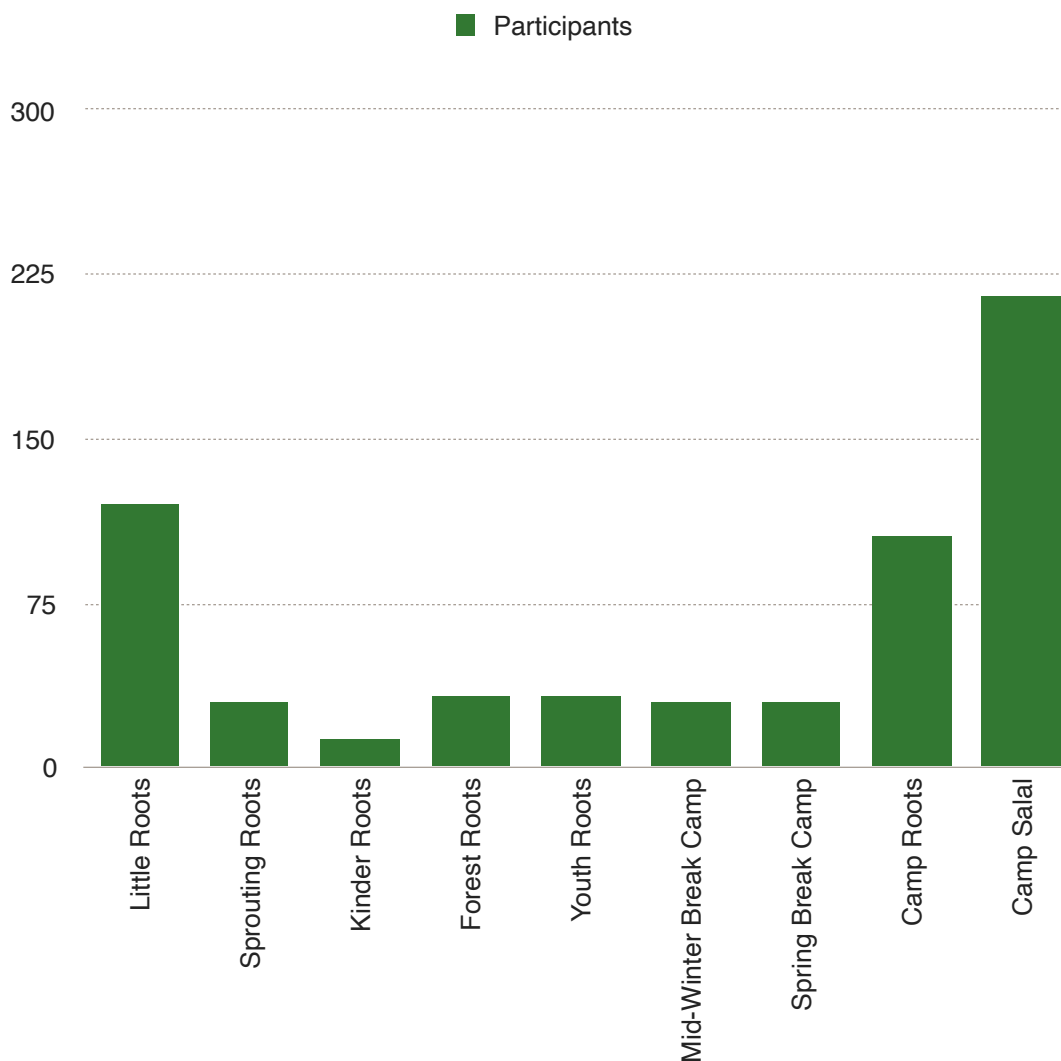
Our main source of income in 2018 was tuition. We diversified our income source this year by participating in two fundraisers.
